AL - Quite dark ruby purple nuance, fairly viscous, the nose is still young and closed but with good purity, dark fruity character and a hint of new oak, very nice density, multi layered with pure dark fruit such as blackberry, blueberry, liquorice, and sweet tannin backed up by a nice freshness, very nice length, still a bit tannic on the finish, but it will definitely soften from further aging, nice potential, drink from 2014. **91**

MdM - Deep purple red with violet hue and almost black centre. Elegant and expressive nose with aromas reminiscent of dark berries, eg blackcurrant and blackberries, vanilla, toasted oak, almost balmy components. On the palate well structured with good concentration, good balance and length. Strong but ripe tannins, wine with great potential. **90**
