NOTES DE DEGUSTATION

Jeb Dunnuck (mai 2025) : Drinking beautifully today, the 2010 Château De Pressac has a classic Saint-Emilion nose of mulled red and black fruits, chocolate, and leafy herbs, with a remarkable sense of chalky minerality. Medium to full-bodied, concentrated, and textured on the palate, it has resolved tannins, solid mid-palate depth and balance, and outstanding length. Count me impressed. It has another decade or more of prime drinking. Drink 2025-2035.
